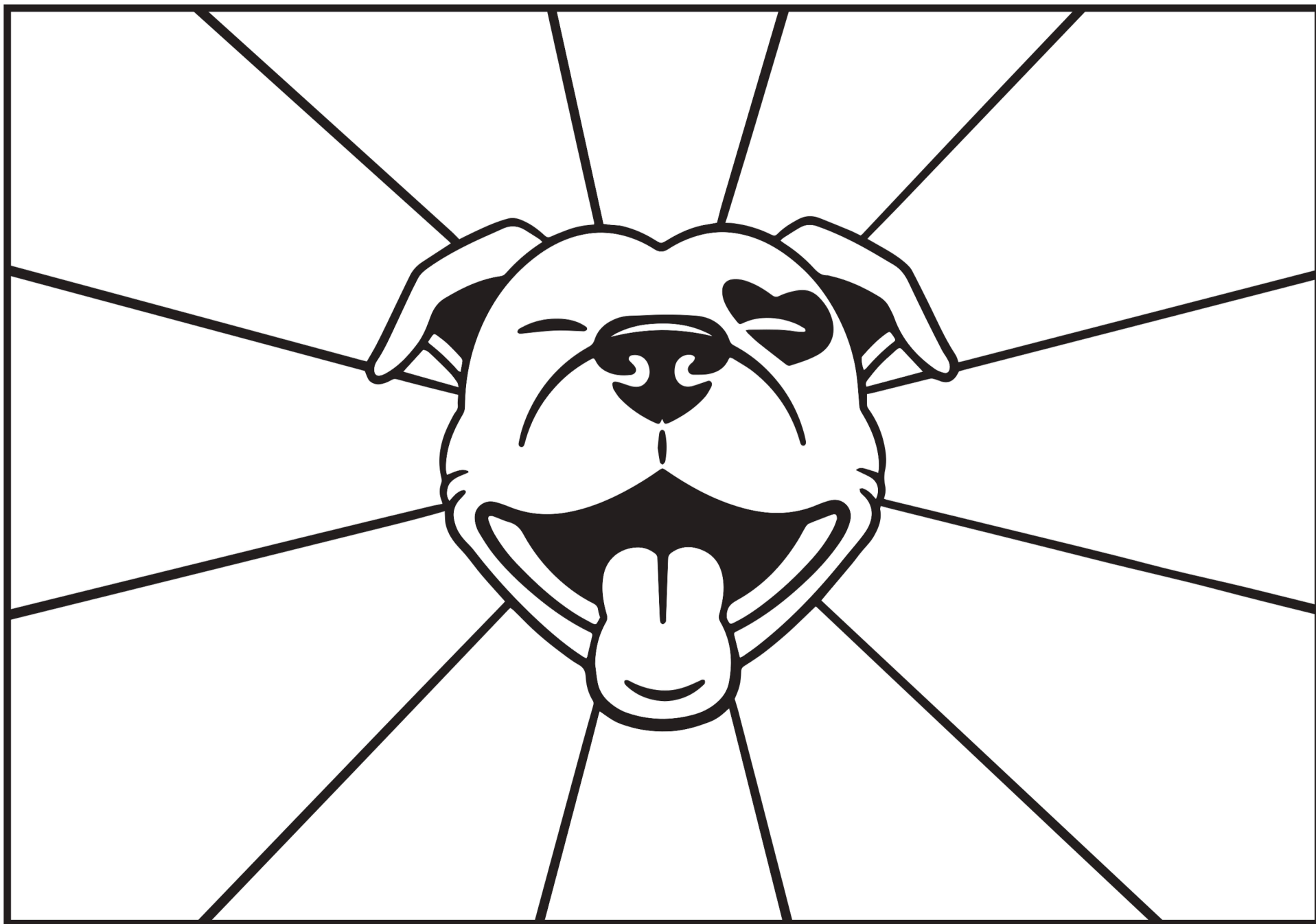

FROM THE DOG'S FACE



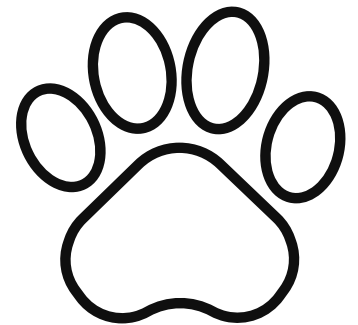
STAND LIKE A TREE IF THE DOG

WHEN THEY ARE EATING

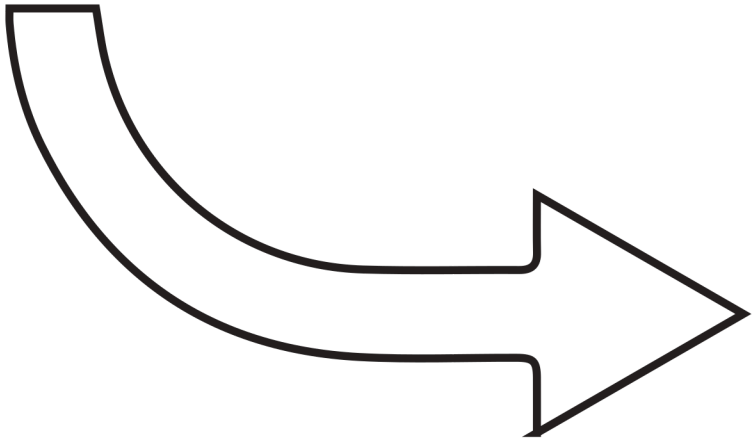


NEVER REACH INTO A CAR

**MEET ANGUS!**

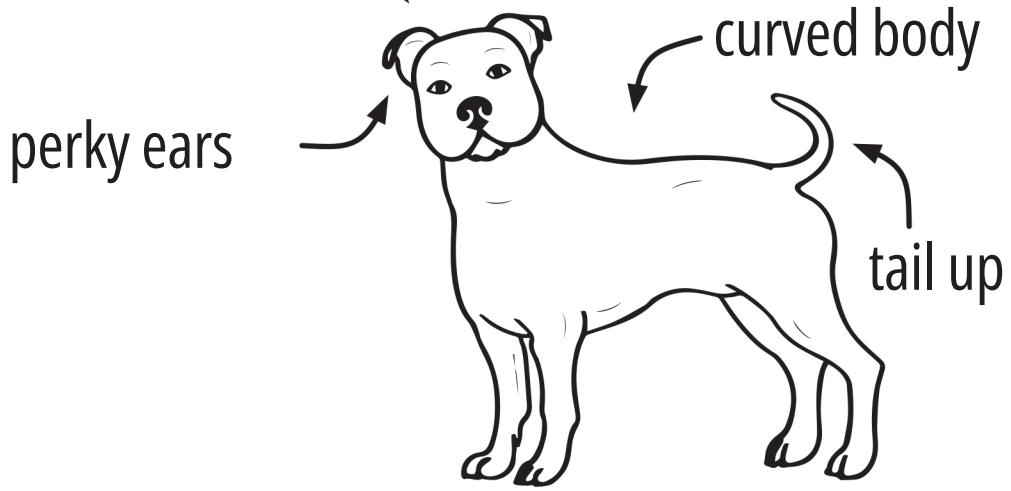
ANGUS IS A FUN LOVING DOG THAT **LOVES**  
PLAYING WITH TOYS, DOGS AND KIDS



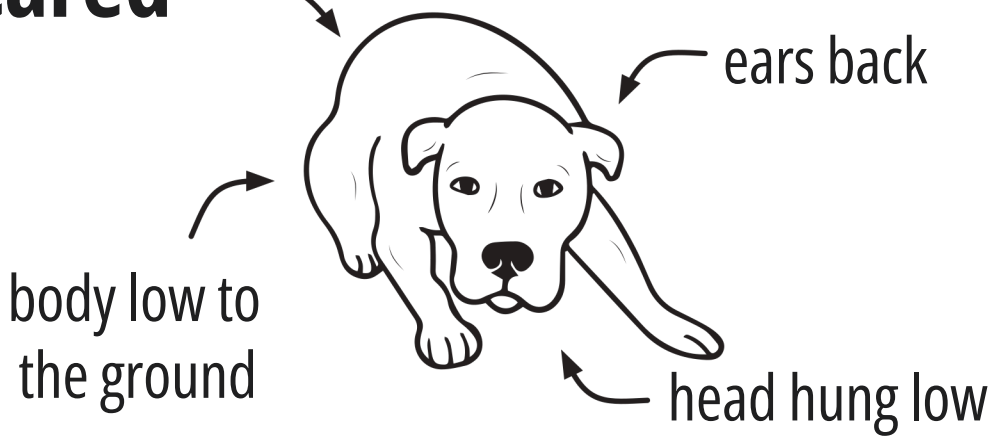
Just remember, dogs **don't like it**

**NEVER BOTHER A DOG THAT IS:**



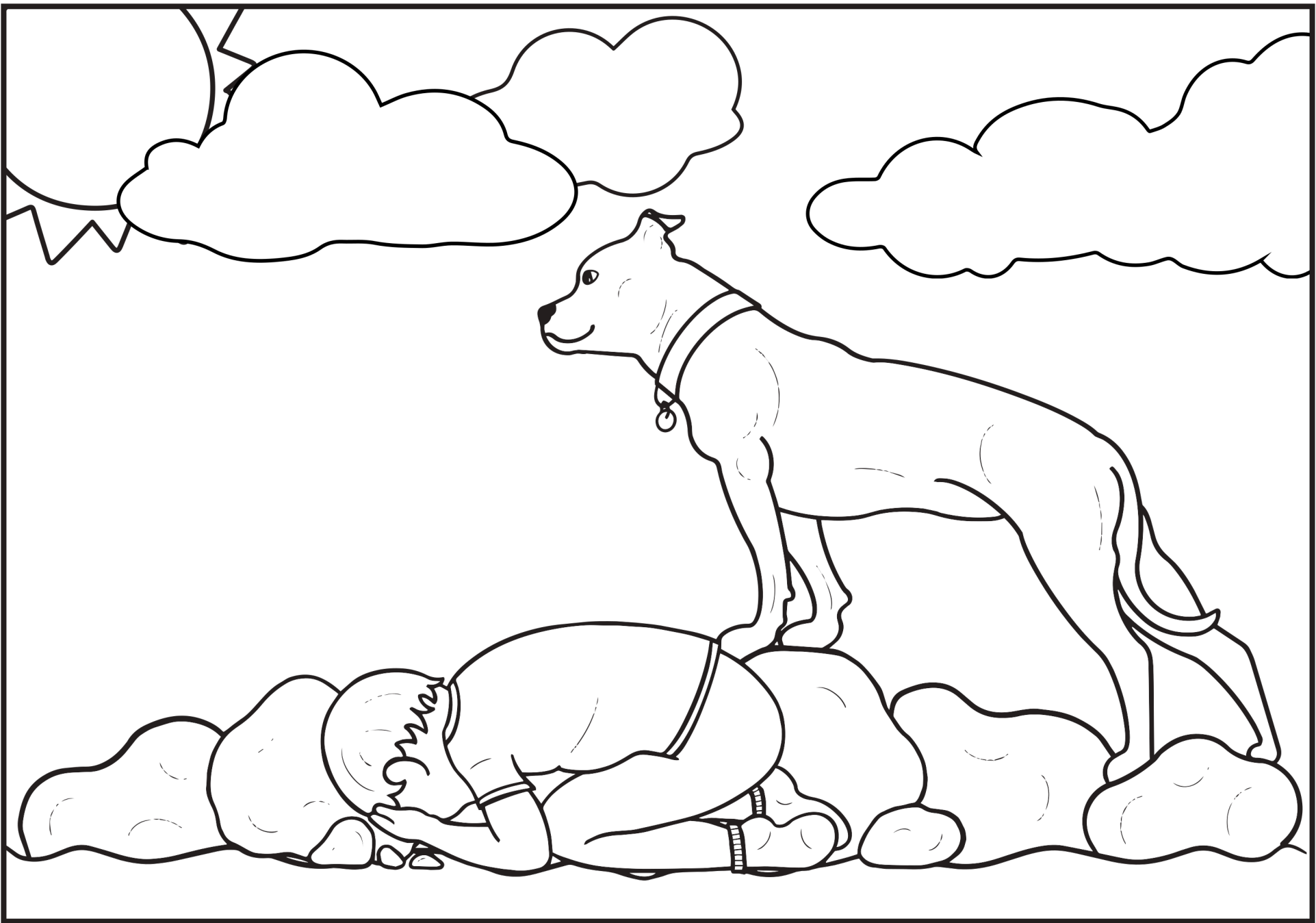
**Always** ask before you pet a dog; **never** put your face in a dog's face.



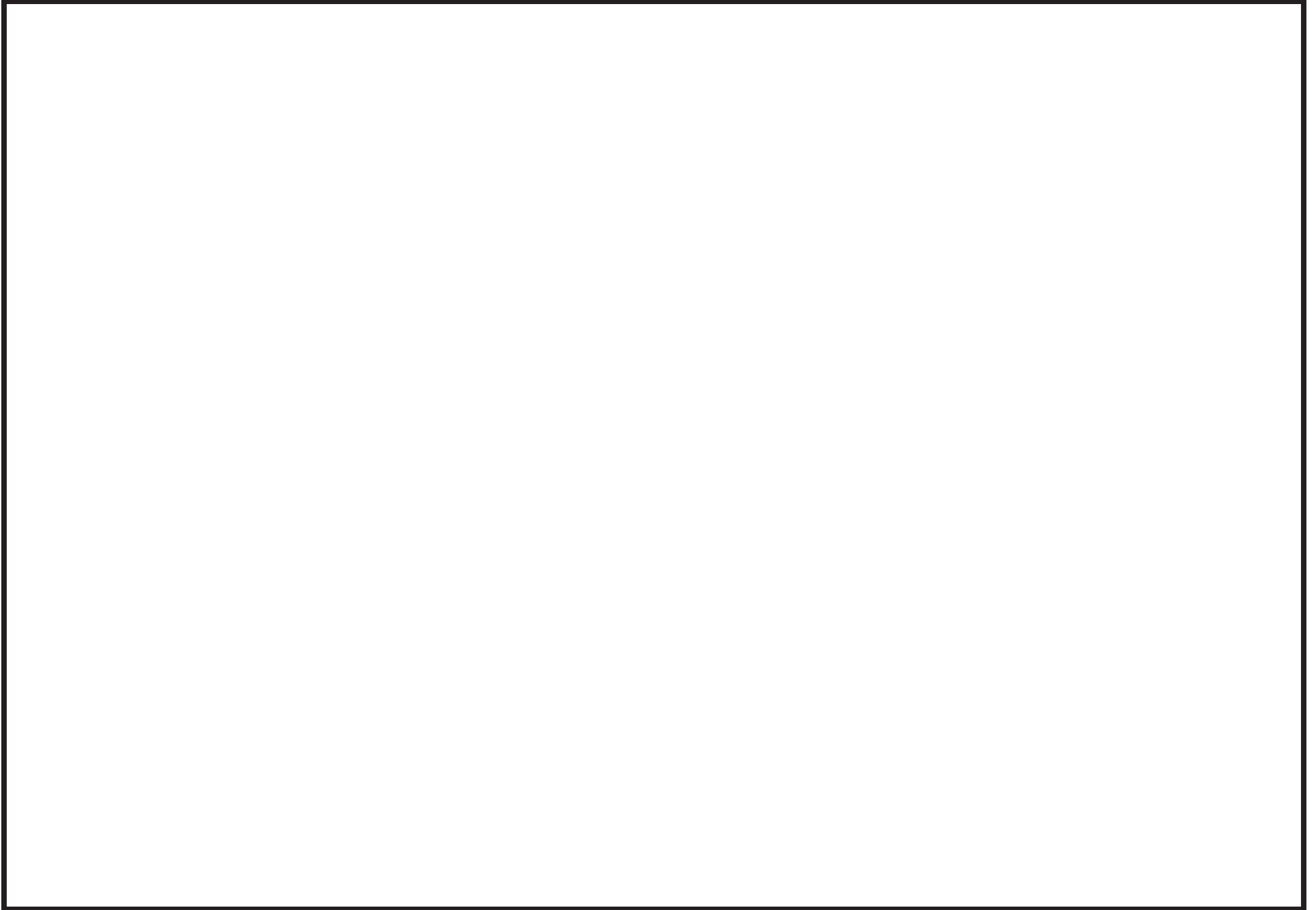
If a dog you don't know approaches, **BE A TREE.**
